Surgical Center Appointment Cancellation Policy

We require that you give our office 24 Hours' notice in the event that you need to reschedule your appointment. This allows for other patients to be scheduled into that appointment. If you miss an appointment without contacting our office within the required time, this is considered a missed appointment. A FEE OF \$100 WILL BE CHARGED TO YOU.

CITROMA INSTRUCTIONS:

1 WEEK PRIOR:

- Fill your prescription for Magnesium Citrate and Dulcolax
- If you have diabetes, check with your doctor regarding diet and medication instructions.
- Please <u>DISCONTINUE</u> iron supplements and blood thinners (<u>Coumadin, Eliquis, Plavix, etc</u>) <u>after discussion with your doctor</u>
- **DO NOT** STOP ASPIRIN unless doctor told you to do so.

1 DAY PRIOR:

- Stay on a clear liquid diet. <u>NO SOLID FOOD (BREAKFAST, LUNCH, or DINNER).</u> Clear liquid includes: (Water, Apple Juice, Ginger Ale, Coffee & Tea (No Milk, No Creamer), Gatorade & Jell-O (<u>NO RED OR PURPLE</u> COLORING), <u>NO ORANGE JUICE</u>
- 2) At 3:00 PM, take 2 <u>Dulcolax</u> Tablets and 1st bottle of <u>Magnesium Citrate (Citroma)</u>.
- 3) At 6:00 PM, take 2 Dulcolax Tablets and 2nd bottle of Magnesium Citrate (Citroma).
- 4) At 9:00 PM, NO Tablets and take the 3rd bottle of Magnesium Citrate (Citroma).
- 5) Nothing is to be taken after <u>MIDNIGHT</u> prior to the procedure.

The Morning of the Procedure:

- If medications (High Blood Pressure) need to be taken in the morning, take them with a sip of water
- No driving within 24 hours after the examination.

Note: If you are on any blood thinning or arthritis medication, you must notify the doctor.

Compliance Notice:

- Follow doctor's instructions carefully. If you do not, the procedure may be cancelled or repeated.
- ** A responsible adult should accompany all patients the day of the procedure. No patient should drive the day of the colonoscopy.**

NOTE: ALL PATIENT'S MUST DO COVID-19 SWAB TEST 5 DAYS BEFORE PROCEDURE DATE
